

GREENWAY TRAILHEADS

475A TRAILHEAD – 11100 SW 16TH AVE., OCALA, FL. 34482

Directions: Airport Road South to Hwy. 200, make a left. Make the first right on the traffic light, that's 66th Street. Stay on 66th Street to the first traffic light, make a right, that's 27th Ave., it will lead to 475. Go to the S curve, bear right; you will see the trailhead entrance on the right.

CHRISTMAS (49TH AVE.) – 12555 SW 49TH AVE., OCALA, FL. 34473

Directions: Take Airport Road straight, cross Hwy. 200 to 95th Street, pass the Freedom Library, continue, it turns to 49th Ave., go straight, you'll cross over the tunnel or overpass, trailhead will be on left.

PRUITT TRAILHEAD – 15430 SW HWY 484, DUNNELLON, FL. 34431

Directions: Hwy 40 towards Dunnellon, make a left on 140th Ave., and a right on Rt. 484. You'll pass the Dunnellon airport. The Pruitt trailhead sign will be on your left.

ROSS PRAIRIE – 10660 SW HWY 200, DUNNELLON, FL., 34431

Directions: Hwy 225A South to Hwy 200, make a right, cross Hwy 484, go about a mile, you will see the trailhead entrance sign to your left.

SANTOS TRAILHEAD – 3080 SE 80TH ST., OCALA, FL. 34491

Directions: Take Hwy 441 South, make a right on 80th St., by the Sheriff's sub-station.

SHANGRI-LA – 12788 SW 69TH CT., OCALA, FL. 34476

Directions: Hwy 225A to Hwy 200, make a right. At intersection light of Rt. 484, make a left. Make another left at the entrance to Marion Oaks trail, another left on 69th Ct. Go to the end of 69th, you will see the entrance gate.

OTHER TRAILHEADS IN THE AREA

BEAR HEAD HAMMOCK – WITHLACOOCHEE STATE FOREST –

(352) 754-6896, Directions: From Dunnellon, take US-41 South 7 miles to CR-491. Turn East on CR-491 and follow it 1.2 miles. Trailhead entrance is on the north side. From Ocala, go South on SR. 200. Travel through the Rt. 484 intersection and continue on SR. 200 to CR- 491 South. Go right or south on CR- 491. Travel about 4 miles, park is on the right.

DOE LAKE HORSE CAMP – OCALA NATIONAL FOREST – C/O SEMINOLE RANGER DISTRICT, 40929

STATE RD. 19, UMATILLA, FL. 32784, (352) 669-3153 Directions: Go east on Rt. 40 to Rt. 314A (Forest Corner); turn right (south) on 314A (also known as 95th St. Rd.). Go past 464C (blinking light) and look for 182nd Ave. on right (south). Watch for Meadors Convenience Store, 9 ½ miles. Go right on 182nd Ave. to Forest Rd. #573 (approx. 3 ½ miles) Turn left; you'll see the Doe Lake entrance, approx. ½ mile.

PAYNE'S PRAIRIE STATE PRESERVE – 100 SAVANNAH BLVD., MICANOPY, FL. 32667, (352) 466-3397,

Directions: Take Hwy 441, pass flashing light in Micanopy, go about ½ mile, entrance will be on your right.

SAN FELASO HAMMOCK PRESERVE STATE PARK – 4732 MILHOPPER RD., GAINESVILLE, FL. 32601

(352) 336-2135, Directions not available.

TIDEWATER – GOETHE STATE FOREST – (352) 447-2202 - Directions: From Dunnellon, take CR 40 to CR 336

North, follow CR 336 North for 5 miles. Turn right on CR 337, go 1/4 mile to dirt road on right and follow trailhead.

WITHLACOOCHEE BAY TRAIL – Directions: From Ocala, follow Hwy. 40 West to Rt. 41 South in Dunnellon.

Continue on Rt. 41 South to intersection of Rt. 484 and Rt. 40. Turn right on Rt. 40 West and continue through Dunnellon and Inglis to US Hwy. 19. Turn left onto Hwy. 19 (Suncoast Blvd.). Cross over the big Cross Fl. Barge Canal Bridge. At the bottom of the bridge, turn left and proceed under the bridge to the left. Follow the vehicle access road all the way to the end (approx. 5 miles). The trailhead is straight ahead through the gate. Bring water for the horses.
